LABOR TRAFFICKING IS...

forcing or coercing someone to do work.

BONDED LABOR (DEBT BONDAGE):

Forced to work to pay debt to the trafficker.

Value of labor is more than the original debt.

Value of the victim's labor is not assessed nor is the victim's labor applied to the debt.

FORCED **LABOR**

Trafficker wields ownership over the victims.

Limits freedom and forces the victim to work through force, threat of force, or punishment.

TYPES OF WORK MIGHT INCLUDE...

Nannies | Housekeepers | Nail technicians | Construction workers | Agricultural work

Hotel & restaurant staff | Factory staff | Fishery staff & crab pickers

VICTIMS ARE OFTEN...

Isolated... Escorted... Not in possession of their own documents... Unable or not allowed to speak for themselves... Telling a story that seems rehearsed or coached... Protective of their trafficker
